Beyond Meat is a producer of plant-based meat headquartered in Los Angeles.

Beyond Meat and Palantir have partnered since October 2022, transforming Beyond Meat's inventory management, supply chain, and quality assurance operations to generate significant cost savings and increase customer satisfaction.

Beyond Meat has deployed Palantir's platforms for an Inventory 360 workflow—in essence, integrating disparate inventory data into a single view to provide a real-time picture of operations. This enables more comprehensive, proactive planning, as well as the ability to anticipate disruptions and mitigate their potential impacts before they occur.

With AIP, Beyond Meat can deploy LLMs to synthesize and analyze emails from vendors to supply chain managers and automatically surface potential disruptions. For example, LLMs are able to detect purchase order delays based on email traffic and recommend inventory reallocations and/or production plan adjustments to minimize the impact of any delays.

Previously, Beyond Meat personnel had to manually identify opportunities to extend ingredient expiration dates, send emails to the Quality Assurance (QA) team requesting tests, and then manually record the results of those tests. This resulted in wasted inventory and inefficiencies for employees.

Palantir software has helped Beyond Meat redeploy unused inventory to usable contexts. AIP automatically flags inventory that is approaching its expiration date so that the QA team can perform their tests and—if appropriate—provide a Certificate of Analysis (COA) allowing the expiration date to be extended.

Beyond Meat will deploy an AI-powered workflow for automatic COA analysis and extraction on incoming inventory.
